## SKNFA REGULATIONS FOR APPLICATION FOR NEW MEMBERSHIP

---

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 11 of the St. Kitts Nevis Football Association (SKNFA) Statutes, the Executive makes the following Regulations:

### 1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the SKNFA New Membership Regulations.

### 2. Purpose of the club

The application must clearly define the purpose of the club.

### 3. The history of the club

The club shall provide information that demonstrates consistent participation in football activities, including but not limited to: leagues, competitions, coach education, youth and grassroots development for a minimum of two years.

### 4. Home Field

The club shall indicate its home field for training and competitions, which must be approved by the relevant authority. A copy of the approval letter shall be submitted with the application.

### 5. Football Activities

The club shall provide information (e.g. Team sheets) about the leagues and or competitions that it has participated in previously, including; senior teams (men and or women), youth and grassroots competitions. The club must provide information on the certification of its coaches and other technical staff in keeping with the requirements of the SKNFA Club Licensing Programme and Rules and Regulations.

The club shall indicate to the SKNFA the leagues and or competitions that its players will be registering for participation.

## 6. Membership

The club shall provide a list of its membership with accompanying signatures who participated in its last voting congress or constitutional meeting.

## 7. Registered players of the club

The club shall provide information; name, address, and date of birth of players who are duly registered members of the club to participate in the leagues and or competitions provided in (5) above.

A player shall not be registered with any other football club in the Federation, or elsewhere. Application shall be accompanied by the signature of the club's players.

## 8. Financial Sustainability

The club shall provide a copy of its most recent financial statements, including a budget for the upcoming year or football season. Additionally, the club may provide information about sponsors or potential sponsors as proof of financial viability.

## 9. Protection of the Rights of Existing Clubs

The SKNFA reserves the right to deny an application for new membership in order to protect the interest, rights, integrity and longevity of its existing member clubs.
